This submission supports the inclusion of the area already shown on the draft map and seeks to extend the boundaries of open country.

## **Description of land submitted**

Meadows Dale (A, B) and the unnamed side valley (C) are the open northern end of a wooded steep sided valley. It has currently no public access, but tracks and small areas of woodland would enable it to connect to Lavender Dale and Brig Dale, and to the Minster Way, giving attractive circular walks.

## Comments supporting vegetation type and justification for inclusion:

Inspection of **aerial photographs** suggests that the valley banks are unimproved, and that the northern area A is little different from the southern area (B,C) or from Brig Dale, both shown as open country on the draft map.

## Conclusion

We think that the evidence presented here suggests that the area mapped, including area A which was not shown on the draft map, is unimproved calcareous grassland and should be mapped as open country.
