This submission suggests that the area mapped, which was not shown on the draft map, should be included as open country.

Description of land submitted

Towthorpe Dale is a steep sided east-west valley to the west of Sledmere. There is no public access to the valley, but a bridleway used as a footpath crosses the dale, and a public road lies along the narrow eastern edge. Side valleys at the western end are wooded, as is some of the northern slope of the main valley; these areas are therefore not included in this claim. The eastern end, although shown on maps as wooded, is in practice a rough open area with some scrub and scattered trees. The main valley is grazed by cattle. Access to this dale would give interesting recreational possibilities.

Comments supporting vegetation type and justification for inclusion:

There is a 2002 Countryside Stewardship Agreement (Chalk and Limestone) for this area.

Study of **aerial photographs** from 2000 for the valley suggests that the steep valley sides are unimproved calcareous grassland.

This view was reinforced by observations of the area from the public footpaths and road during a **visit** in September 2003.

Conclusion

We think the evidence presented here suggests that the area mapped, which was not shown on the draft map, should be mapped as open country.
